

LifeSight Cookie Notice

Last Revised: May 2018

This Cookie Notice describes the types of cookies and similar technologies that may be used by WTW on LifeSight.

Cookies are small text files sent by websites to your computer or other device that can be used to make a user's experience more efficient.

We only use essential cookies to enable LifeSight to function properly and to ensure you get the best experience whilst using LifeSight.

Essential cookies

We may store information using cookies which we can access when you visit our site in future. The cookies listed below are essential to the functionality of the site. You can access them through some types of browser.

Cookie Name	Cookie Description
csrftoken	This cookie helps to provide additional protection against Cross Site Request Forgeries.
epa_sessid	This cookie is used to help manage your sessions. Session cookies allow users to be recognised within a website so any page changes, item or data selection you do is remembered from page to page.
sessionid	This cookie is also used to help manage your sessions within LifeSight.
epav2 & epa_towerswatsoncda	These cookies are used to ensure that relevant data is returned and presented to you when browsing the Site.
scheme	A scheme identifier, used in the configuration of LifeSight.
bgroup	This is also used as an identifier to configure the Site, and relates to the scheme's business or organisation.
OMCtrack	Oracle Management Cloud Tracker – used to monitor performance and security of the LifeSight Site.
anoncsrf	This is a security cookie used to help prevent attacks such as Cross-Site Request Forgery (CSRF).

Third party cookies

Please note that third parties (including, for example, providers of external services like financial modelling tools) may also use cookies which are essential to the functionality of their services, but over which we have no control. These cookies are likely to be analytical/performance cookies such as:

Cookie Name	Cookie Description
_ga	This Google Analytics cookie may be used by third parties where financial modelling tools are offered. This cookie is used to distinguish unique users by

	assigning a randomly generated number as a client identifier. This helps us measure how many people use the tools.
_gat	Used by Google Analytics to manage the request rate and may be used where third party financial modelling tools are offered. This cookie limits the collection of data on high traffic sites.
_gid	This cookie is associated with Google Universal Analytics to store and update a unique value for each page visited. This may be used where third party financial modelling tools are offered.
